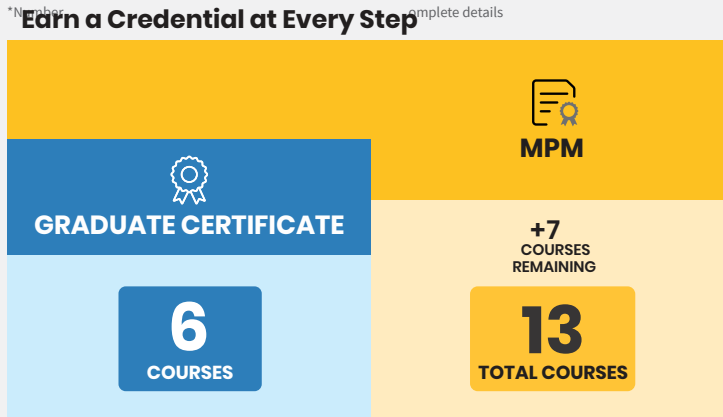
PROGRAM CORE
